Luke 18:35-43

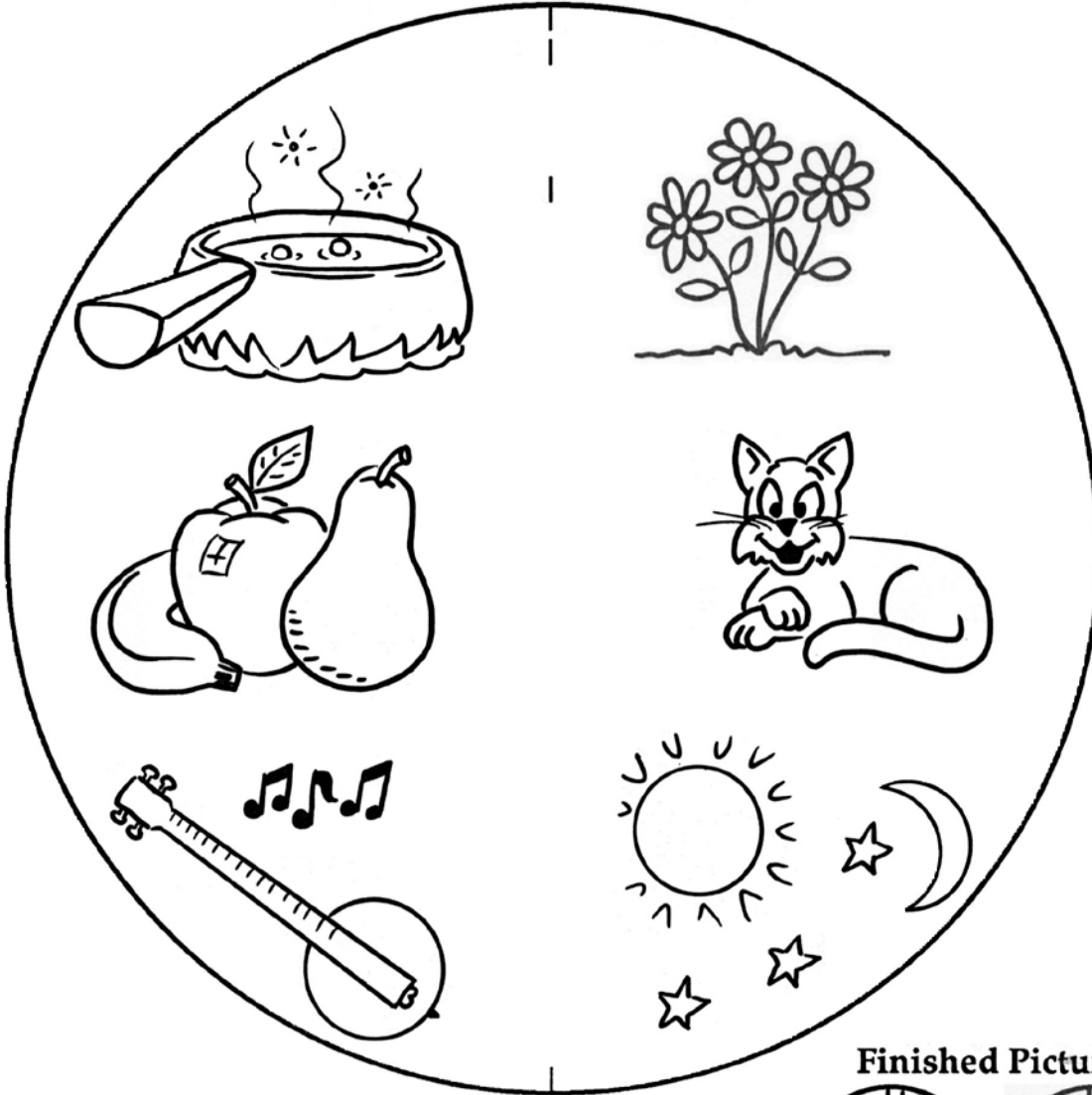


Close your eyes. Pretend that you are the man waiting for someone to help you. You can smell fragrant flowers.

cannot see.

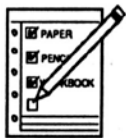
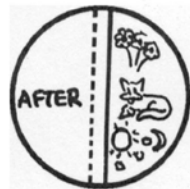

*For the Teacher:* Pass around an item for each sense: SMELL a rose or perfume, TASTE a slice of fruit, TOUCH a smooth stone, HEAR a bell, SEE a picture book. For each child, pre-cut a half circle from colored paper and a whole circle from the pattern. After they color, put glue along the broken lines and let them attach the half circle. Fold it back and let it dry. Help them add the words. Talk about what the blind man could see after Jesus helped him.
