		God Blesses Abraham (Genesis 12 – 13)	<i>Let us hold tightly without wavering to the hope we affirm, for God can be trusted to keep his promise. (Hebrews 10:23)</i>
		Abraham's Faith is Tested (Genesis 21 – 22)	<i>When troubles of any kind come your way, consider it an opportunity for great joy. For you know that when your faith is tested, your endurance has a chance to grow. (James 1:2-3)</i>
		Isaac Gets a Bride (Genesis 24)	<i>Trust in the LORD with all your heart; do not depend on your own understanding. Seek his will in all you do, and he will show you which path to take. (Proverbs 3:5-6)</i>
		Jacob Gets Esau's Birthright (Genesis 25)	<i>Deceit fills hearts that are plotting evil; joy fills hearts that are planning peace. (Proverbs 12:20)</i>
		Jacob Gets Esau's Blessing (Genesis 27)	<i>The faithful love of the LORD never ends! His mercies never cease. Great is his faithfulness; his mercies begin afresh each morning. (Lamentations 3:22-23)</i>
		Jacob's Dream (Genesis 28)	<i>If we confess our sins to him, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all wickedness. (1 John 1:9)</i>
		Jacob Gets Two Wives (Genesis 29)	<i>Let's not get tired of doing what is good. At just the right time we will reap a harvest of blessing if we don't give up. (Galatians 6:9)</i>
		Jacob Leaves Laban (Genesis 30 – 31)	<i>Don't sin by letting anger control you. Do not let the sun go down while you are still angry, for anger gives a foothold to the devil. (Ephesians 4:26-27)</i>
		Jacob Comes Home (Genesis 32 – 33)	<i>Be kind to each other, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, just as God through Christ has forgiven you. (Ephesians 4:32)</i>
		Joseph Sold by His Brothers (Genesis 37)	<i>...love your enemies, bless those who curse you, do good to those who hate you, and pray for those who spitefully use you and persecute you. (Matthew 5:44 NKJ)</i>
		Joseph's Temptation (Genesis 39)	<i>...the Spirit who lives in you is greater than the spirit who lives in the world. (1 John 4:4)</i>
		Pharaoh's Dream (Genesis 40 – 41)	<i>We know that God causes everything to work together for the good of those who love God and are called according to his purpose for them. (Romans 8:28)</i>
		Joseph's Brothers Go to Egypt (Genesis 41 – 43)	<i>If you forgive those who sin against you, your heavenly Father will forgive you. But if you refuse to forgive others, your Father will not forgive your sins. (Matthew 6:14-15)</i>
		Joseph Forgives His Brothers (Genesis 44 – 45)	<i>Forgive us our sins, as we have forgiven those who sin against us. (Matthew 6:12)</i>
		Israelites Settle in Goshen (Genesis 46-50)	<i>"And I will forgive their wickedness, and I will never again remember their sins." (Jeremiah 31:34)</i>
