|      |         | Jacob's Dream<br>(Genesis 28)                      | <i>If we confess our sins to him, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all wickedness. (1 John 1:9)</i>  |
|      |         | Jacob Gets Two Wives<br>(Genesis 29)               | <i>Let's not get tired of doing what is good. At just the right time we will reap a harvest of blessing if we don't give up. (Galatians 6:9)</i>  |
|      |         | Jacob Leaves Laban<br>(Genesis 30 – 31)            | <i>Don't sin by letting anger control you. Do not let the sun go down while you are still angry, for anger gives a foothold to the devil. (Ephesians 4:26-27)</i>                         |
|      |         | Jacob Comes Home<br>(Genesis 32 – 33)              | <i>Be kind to each other, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, just as God through Christ has forgiven you. (Ephesians 4:32)</i>   |
|      |         | Joseph Sold by His Brothers<br>(Genesis 37)        | <i>...love your enemies, bless those who curse you, do good to those who hate you, and pray for those who spitefully use you and persecute you. (Matthew 5:44 NKJ)</i>                    |
|      |         | Joseph's Temptation<br>(Genesis 39)                | <i>...the Spirit who lives in you is greater than the spirit who lives in the world. (1 John 4:4)</i>   |
|      |         | Pharaoh's Dream<br>(Genesis 40 – 41)               | <i>We know that God causes everything to work together for the good of those who love God and are called according to his purpose for them. (Romans 8:28)</i>                             |
|      |         | Joseph's Brothers Go to Egypt<br>(Genesis 41 – 43) | <i>If you forgive those who sin against you, your heavenly Father will forgive you. But if you refuse to forgive others, your Father will not forgive your sins. (Matthew 6:14-15)</i>    |
