		Belt of Truth Ephesians 6:14a	<i>We use God's mighty weapons, not worldly weapons, to knock down the strongholds of human reasoning and to destroy false arguments. (2 Corinthians 10:4 NLT)</i> <i>"Stand therefore, having fastened on the belt of truth..." (Ephesians 6:14a ESV)</i>
		The Breastplate of Righteousness Ephesians 6:14b	<i>Therefore, take up the whole armor of God, that you may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand firm. (14) Stand therefore, having fastened on the belt of truth, and having put on the breastplate of righteousness. (Ephesians 6:13-14 ESV)</i>
		The Gospel of Peace Shoes Ephesians 6:15	<i>For shoes, put on the peace that comes from the Good News so that you will be fully prepared (Ephesians 6:15 NLT)</i>
		The Shield of Faith Ephesians 6:16	<i>God's way is perfect. All the LORD's promises prove true. He is a shield for all who look to Him for protection. (2 Samuel 22:31 NLT)</i> <i>In addition to all of these, hold up the shield of faith to stop the fiery arrows of the devil. (Ephesians 6:16 NLT)</i>
		The Helmet of Salvation Ephesians 6:17	<i>But let us who live in the light be clearheaded, protected by the armor of faith and love, and wearing as our helmet the confidence of our salvation. (1 Thessalonians 5:8 NLT)</i> <i>Put on salvation as your helmet. (Ephesians 6:17a NLT)</i>

		The Sword of the Spirit Ephesians 6:17b	<i>Every word of God proves true. He is a shield to all who come to him for protection. (Proverbs 30:5 NLT)</i> <i>And take the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God. (Ephesians 6:17b NLT)</i>
		Watch and Pray Ephesians 6:18	<i>Keep watch and pray, so that you will not give in to temptation. (Mark 14:38a NLT)</i> <i>Pray in the Spirit at all times and on every occasion. Stay alert and be persistent in your prayers for all believers everywhere. (Eph 6:18 NLT)</i>
