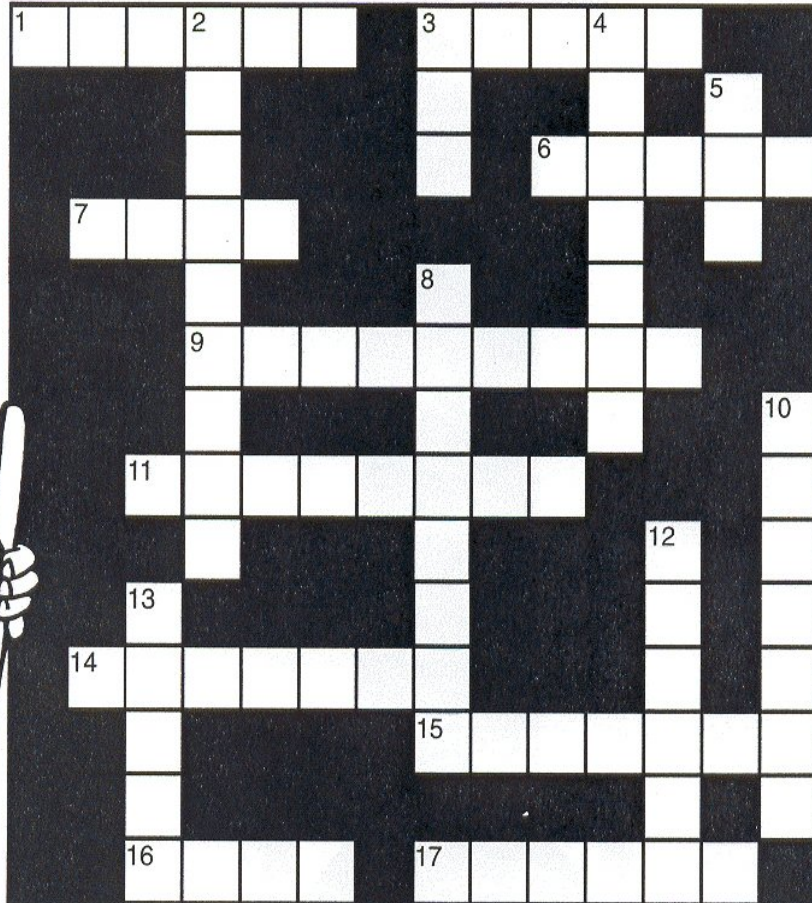


The Good Samaritan
