Week #	Date	Lesson	Memory Verse
1		How Did the World Begin? (Genesis 1:1)	<i>In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth. (Genesis 1:1)</i>
2		Day #1: Light & Darkness (Genesis 1:1-5)	<i>Then Jesus spoke to them again, saying, "I am the light of the world. He who follows Me shall not walk in darkness, but have the light of life." (John 8:12)</i>
3		Day #2: Atmosphere/Separated Waters (Genesis 1:6-8)	<i>The heavens are Yours, the earth also is Yours; the world and all its fullness, You have founded them. (Psalm 89:11)</i>
4		Day #3: Land, Sea, Vegetation (Genesis 1:9-13)	<i>Where were you when I laid the foundations of the earth? Tell Me, if you have understanding. (Job 38:4)</i>
5		Day #4: Sun, Moon, Stars, Season, Days, Years (Genesis 1:14-19)	<i>When I consider Your heavens, the work of Your fingers, the moon and the stars, which You have ordained, what is man that You are mindful of him? (Psalm 8:3-4)</i>
6		Day #5: Fish & Birds (Genesis 1:20-23)	<i>But now ask...and the birds of the air, and they will tell you...and the fish of the sea will explain to you. Who among all these does not know that the hand of the Lord has done this? (Job 12:7-9)</i>
7		Day #6: Animals, Man & Woman (Genesis 1:24-31; 2:7-8; 18-24)	<i>A psalm of David. The heavens proclaim the glory of God. The skies display his craftsmanship. Day after day they continue to speak; night after night they make him known. (Psalms 19:1-2)</i>
8		Man is Unique From Animal & More Precious to God. We are not evolved (Matthew 10:31)	<i>Look at the birds of the air; for they neither sow nor reap nor gather into barns; yet your heavenly Father feeds them. Are you not of more value than they? (Matthew 6:26)</i>
9		Day #7: Sabbath Rest (Genesis 2:1-3)	<i>All Your works shall praise You, O Lord, and Your saints shall bless You. They shall speak of the glory of Your kingdom, and talk of Your power, to make known to the sons of men His mighty acts, and the glorious majesty of His kingdom. (Psalm 145:10-12)</i>
10		Sin Enters World (Genesis 2:7 - 3:24; Romans 3:23; 1John 1:9)	<i>If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. (1 John 1:9)</i>
11		Cain and Abel (Genesis 4:1-16)	<i>The LORD is more pleased when we do what is right and just than when we offer Him sacrifices. (Proverbs 21:3).</i>
12		Civilization, not Cavemen (Genesis 4:16 - 5:32)	<i>Cain built a city...Jabal raised livestock...Jubal played the harp and flute...Tubal-Cain forged all kinds of tools out of bronze and iron. (Genesis 4:17-22)</i>
13		Noah and the Flood (Genesis 6:1 - 9:17)	<i>When I see the rainbow in the clouds, I will remember the eternal covenant between God and every living creature on earth. (Gen 9:16)</i>
14		Tower of Babel (Genesis 11:1-9)	<i>And He has made from one blood every nation of men to dwell on all the face of the earth, and has determined...the boundaries of their habitation... (Acts 17:26)</i>
