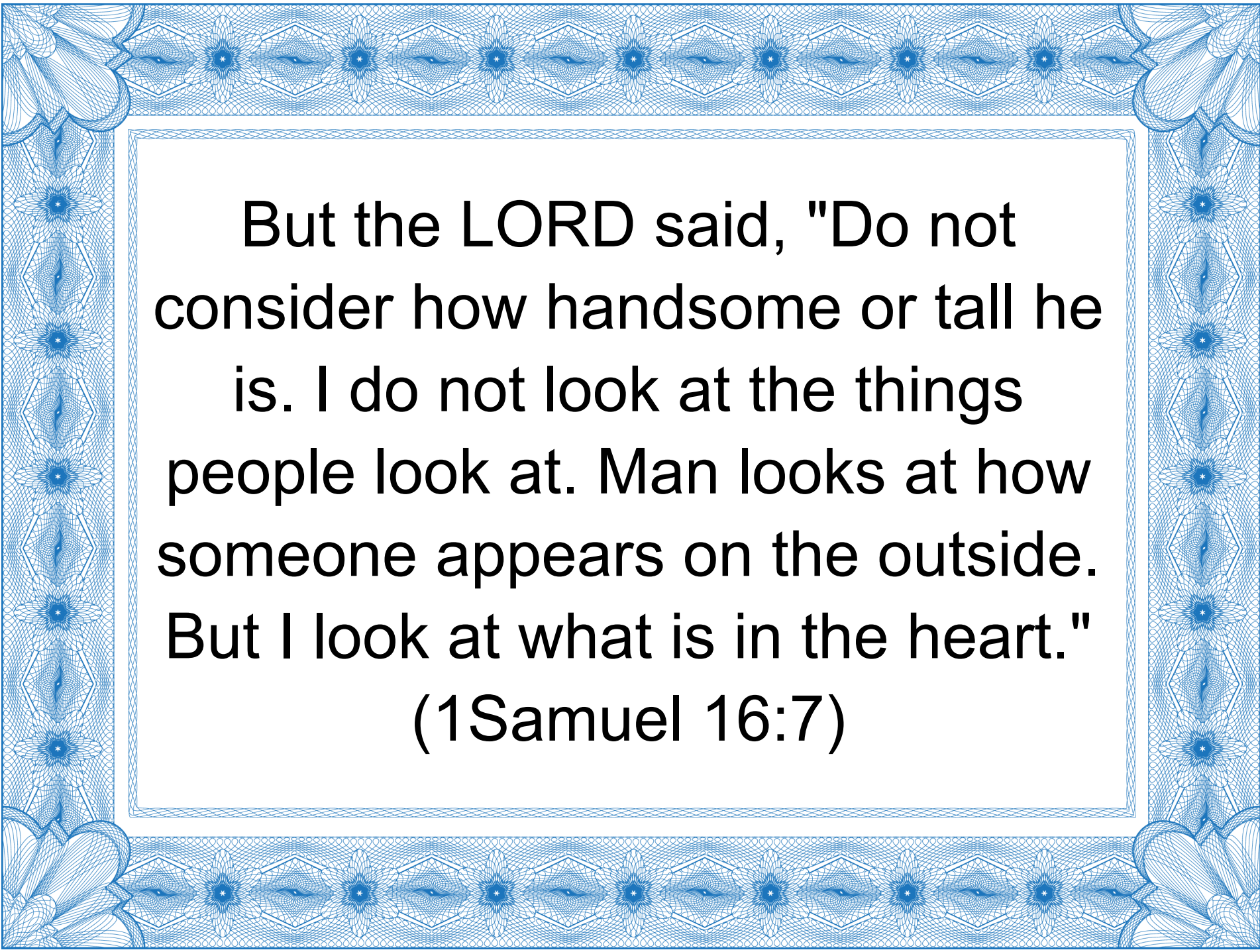


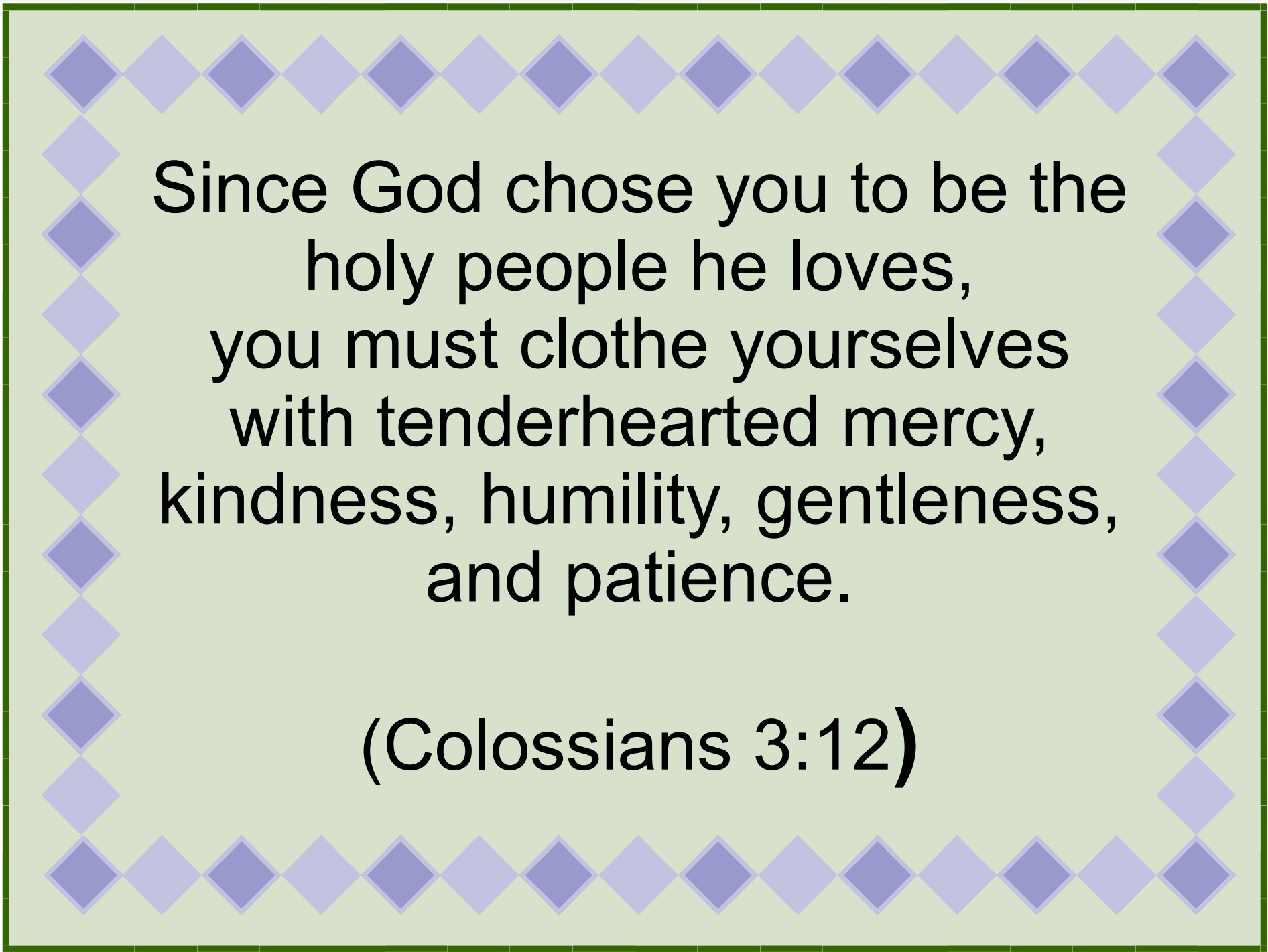


Love is

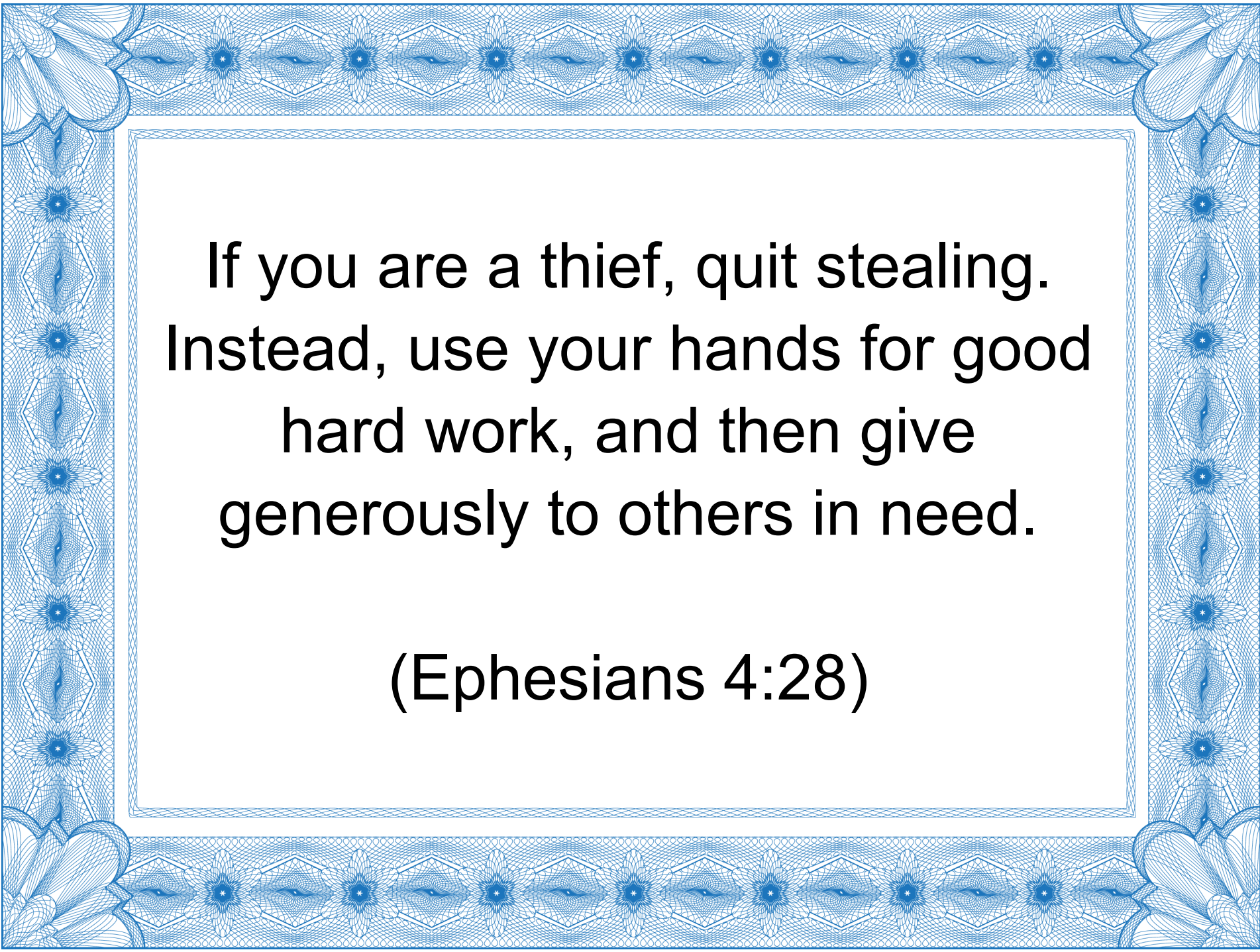

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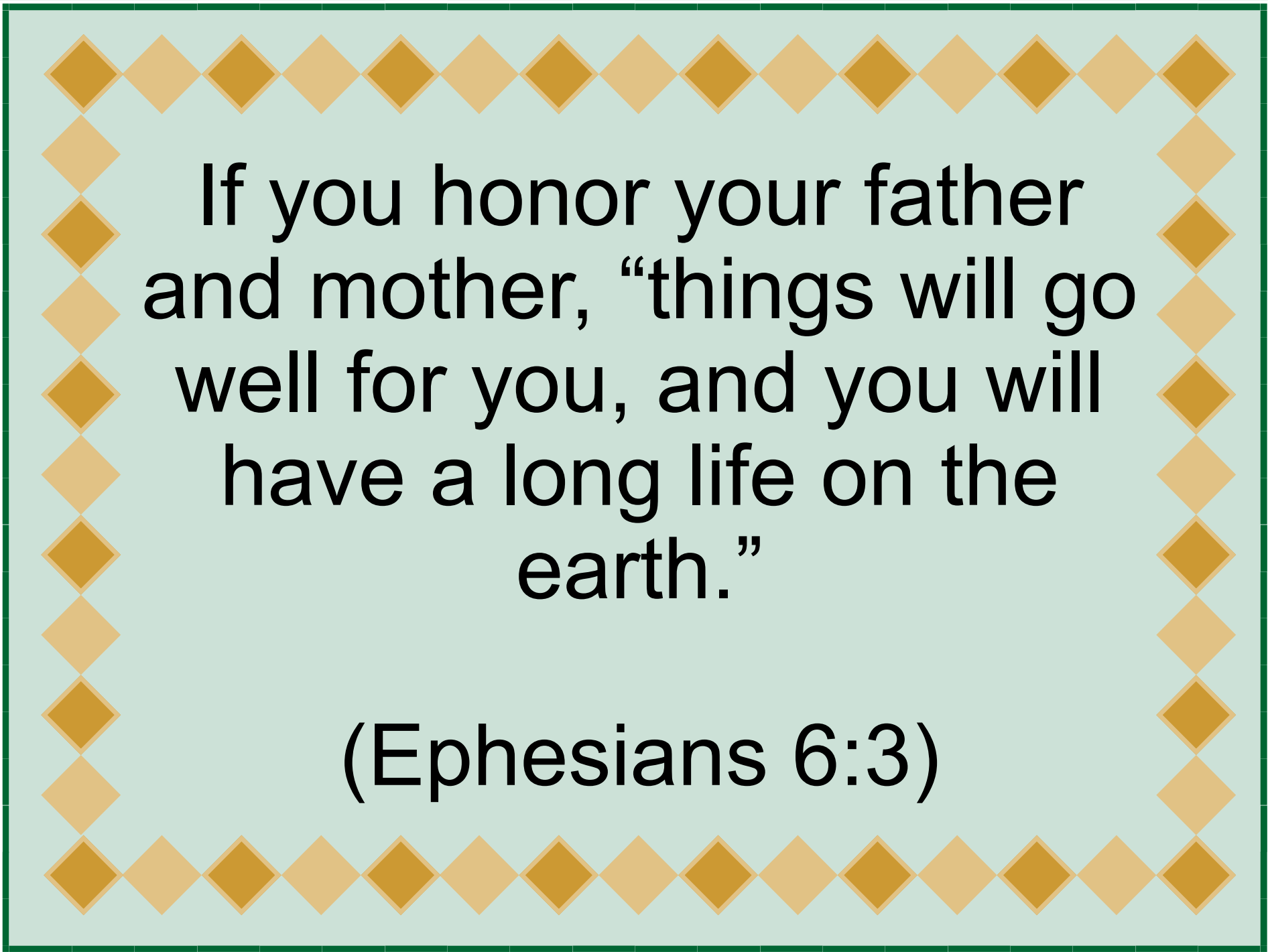
Be kind to one another,

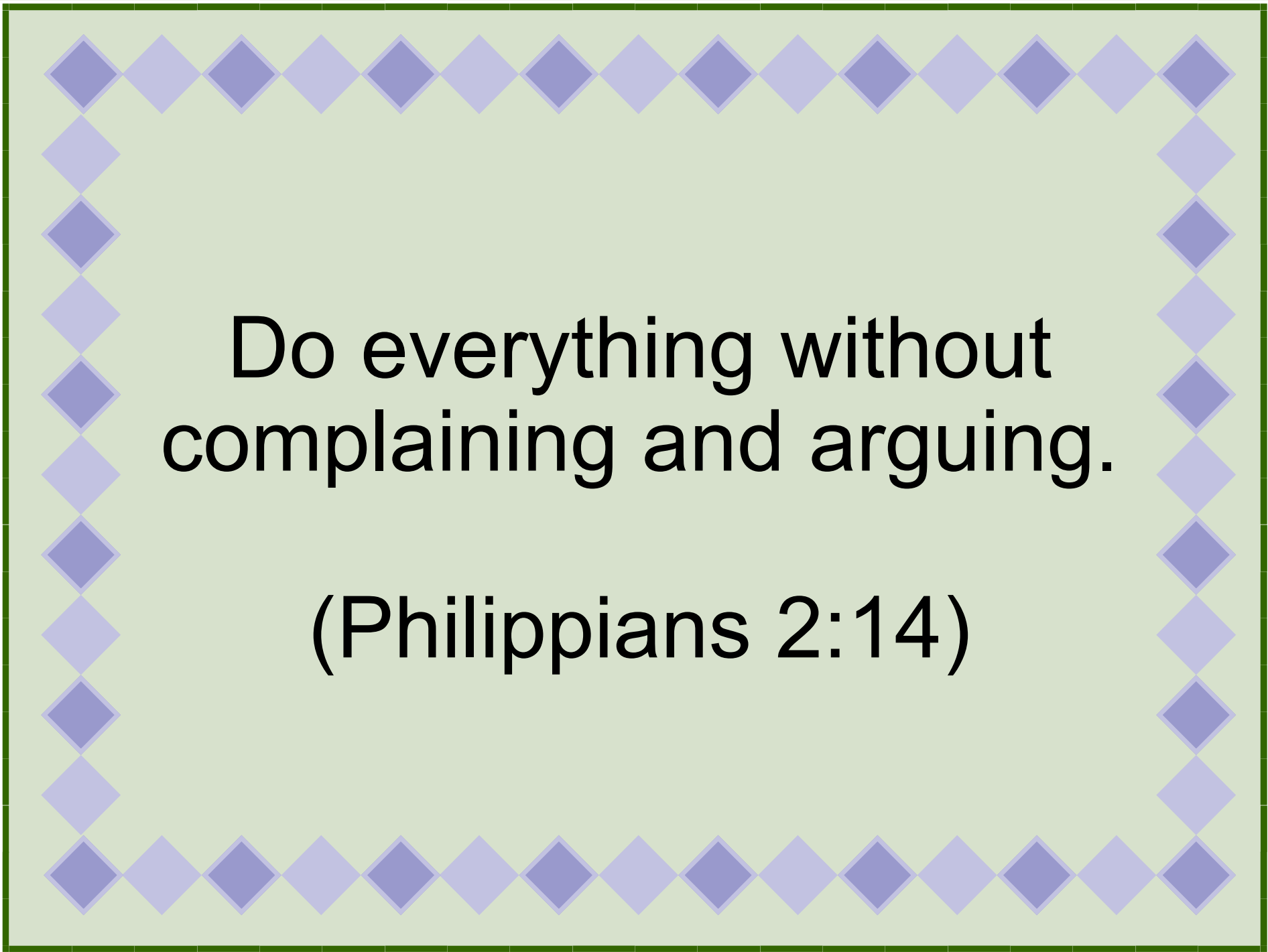
Do not look for advice from

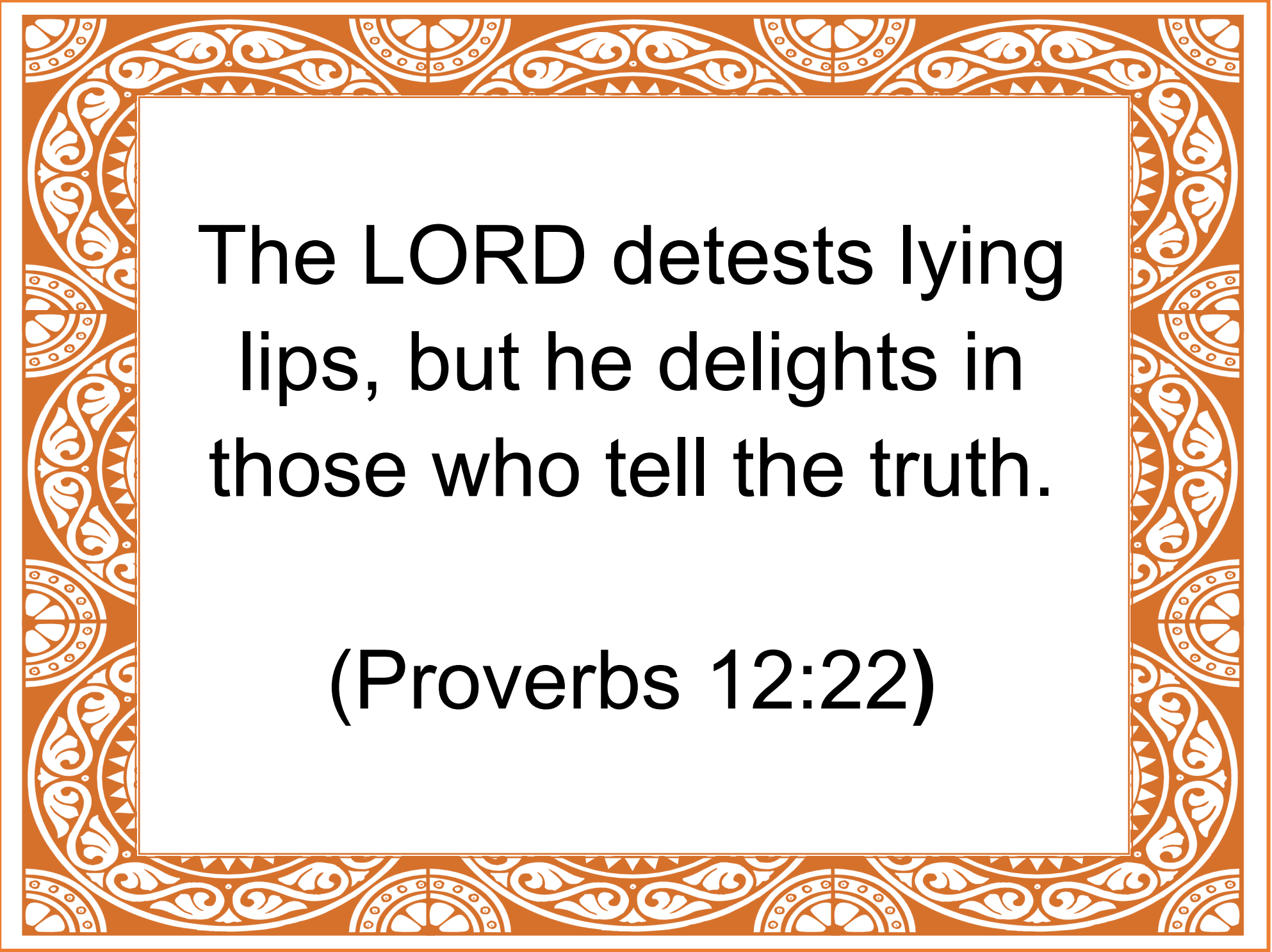

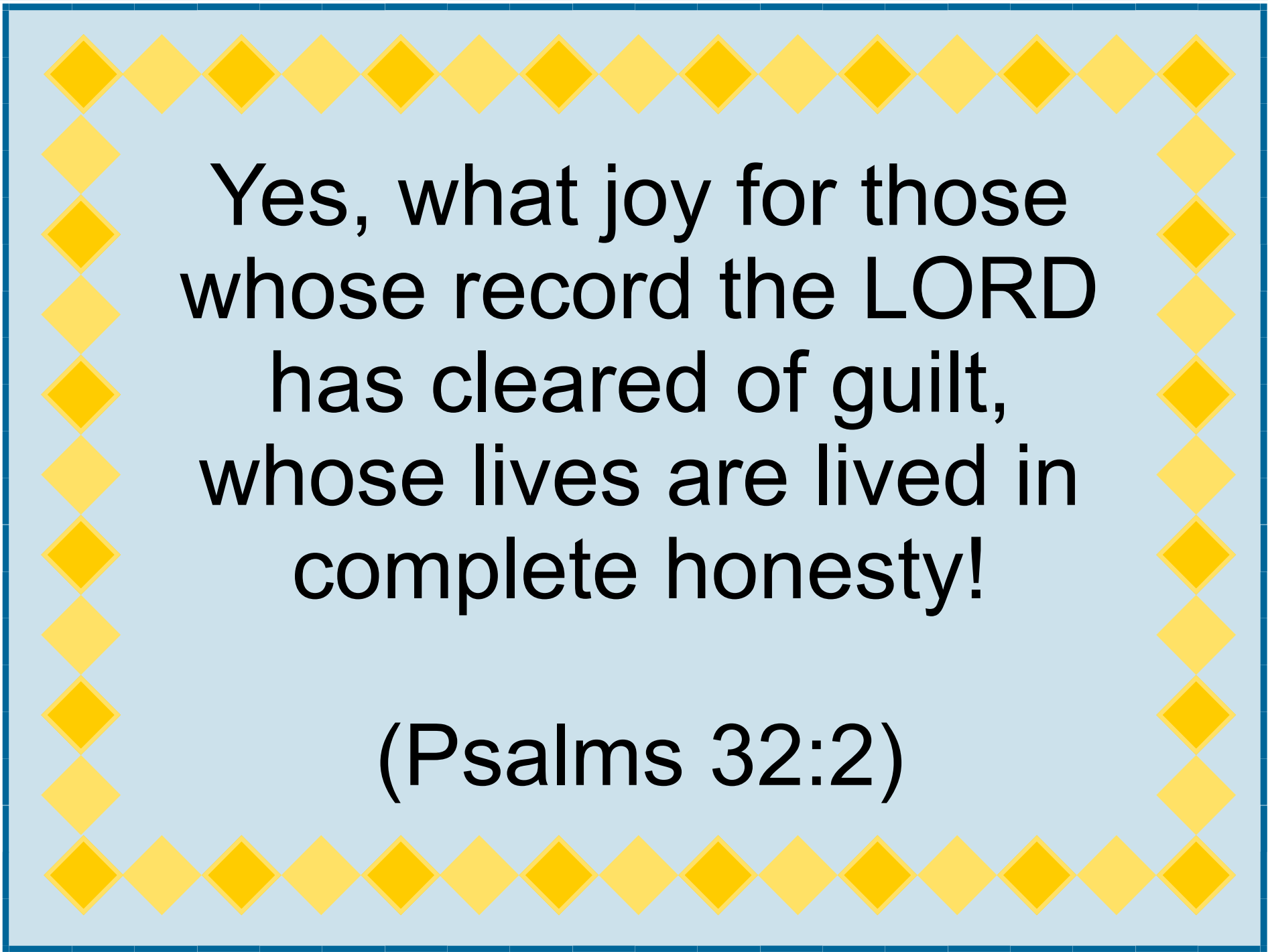

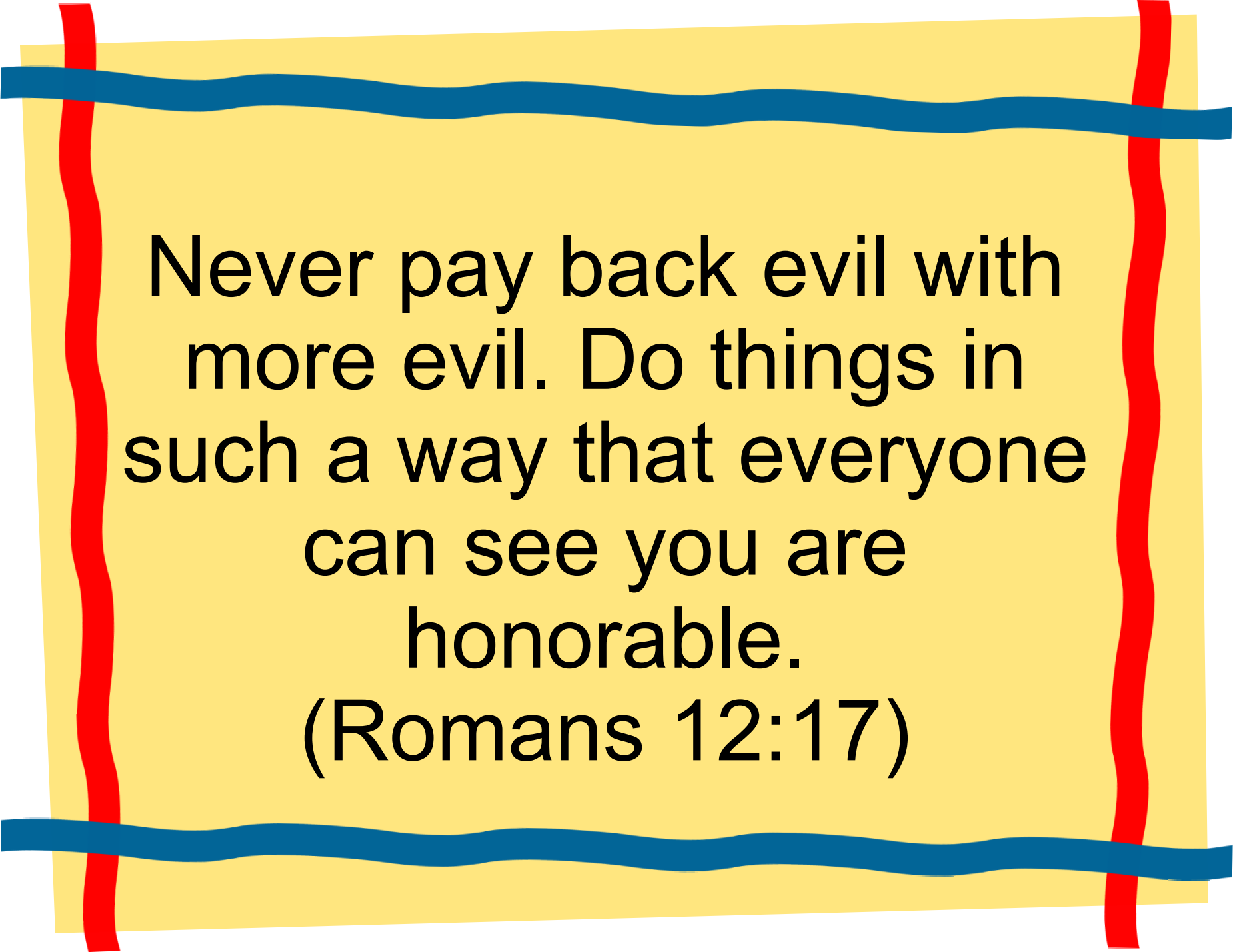
