		Various "Kingdom" Parables, Part 1 (Matthew 13)	<i>I will open My mouth in parables; I will utter things which have been kept secret from the foundation of the world.</i> (Matthew 13:35b)
		Various "Kingdom" Parables, Part 2 (Matthew 13)	<i>He replied, "You are permitted to understand the secret of the Kingdom of God. But I use parables for everything I say to outsiders,</i> (Mark 4:11)
		Prodigal Son (Luke 15:11-32)	<i>Or do you despise the riches of His goodness, forbearance, and longsuffering, not knowing that the goodness of God leads you to repentance?</i> (Romans 2:4)
		Good Samaritan (Luke 10:25-37)	<i>Love knows no harm to a neighbor; therefore, love is the fulfillment of the law.</i> (Romans 13:10) And/or <i>But love your enemies, do good, and lend, hoping for nothing in return; and your reward will be great, and you will be sons of the Highest. For He is kind to the unthankful and evil.</i> (Luke 6:35) And/or <i>Whoever knows the right thing to do and fails to do it, for him it is sin.</i> (James 4:17)
